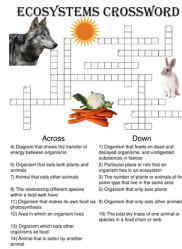


# Y8 Mastery – Global Climate Zones

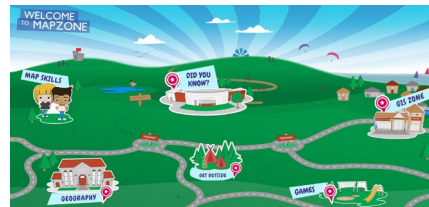
The climate of our planet is changing. Find out about climate change and the risks to our planet. Can it be stopped or reversed? What do you think?
