Objectives:

- to be organised and ready to start the course
 - to be familiar with how the online text book works
 - to have considered how psychology has changed over time
1. Get organised – please get yourself a ring binder folder and a set of dividers for your psychology work. There are 6 areas to be covered in y12 so you will need a divider for these:

 - Memory
 - Attachment
 - Approaches (including biopsychology)
 - Psychopathology
 - Research methods
