As a national youth programme, NCS is made up of a number of regional providers – and that's where Sheffield Wednesday Community Programme comes in. The NCS team will be talking to all Year 11s about the opportunities this summer.

Reducing the contribution to £10; my team here at Sheffield Wednesday Community Programme are happy to discuss these further with you.
