

Learning while isolating

What has changed?

If a pupil needs to self-isolate, they will be able to access lessons in one of two ways, depending on their age and their teacher's preference.

If self-isolating, pupils should check their school emails to see whether they should attend live lessons on Teams or use the eLearning resources (KS3 only).

Live lessons on Teams will be accessed through the Teams calendar or via links emailed by the class teacher.
Please note, Teams lessons may not begin until 5 minutes after the lesson start time (eg. 9.05am).

How will my child access lessons if they are self-isolating?

KS3: Lessons will be delivered live using Teams OR work will be uploaded to the eLearning section of the website.

KS4 & KS5: lessons will be delivered live using Teams. They will begin 5 minutes after lesson start time.

All key stages: Lessons will be delivered live using Teams, according to the normal school timetable.

Live lessons will differ slightly from those taught in lockdown, due to most students being in school. They will begin 5 minutes after lesson start time.

eLearning work will cover what is being taught in school.

Live lessons will differ slightly to those taught during lockdown, due to most students being in school.

These live lessons will likely be very similar to lessons delivered during lockdown.
