Learning while isolating

What has changed?

If a pupil needs to self-isolate, they will be able to access lessons in one of two ways, depending on their age and their teacher's preference.



If self-isolating, pupils should check their school emails to see whether they should attend live lessons on Teams or use the elearning resources (KS3 only).

Live lessons on Teams will be accessed through the Teams calendar or via links emailed by the class teacher.

Please note, Teams lessons may not begin until 5 minutes after the lesson start time (eq. 9.05am).
