Dear Parent/Carer,

At midday on Wednesday 28th February 2024 Year 7 reports shall be uploaded to pupils' MCAS profiles. You can view this by selecting the 'Reports' section within the menu of your child's page. We have already begun to share assessment results and next steps in lessons with our Year 7 pupils in order to quickly drive progress.

I hope that this has focused the minds of pupils on what needs to be done to achieve what they need to meet their expectations. This will be achieved hand in hand with a focus on behaviour, attendance and the steps required to achieve target grades.

For each subject, the following information will appear in your child's data report:

- **Assessment Percentage** – This is the percentage that your child achieved in the most recent assessments, taken in January 2024.
- **Average Assessment Percentage achieved by Year 7** – This is something we produced after consultation with families during the last academic year. I hope that this supports pupils and families contextualise their progress and achievement. This shows the average percentage achieved within each individual subject assessment.
- **A Behaviour for Learning Judgement** please see attached for further details of the meaning behind each score.
- **Meeting Expectations**
 - 'Y' and a green coloured box – this indicates they are meeting or exceeding their teacher's expectations.
 - 'N' and an orange coloured box – this indicates they are not yet meeting expectations.
- **Additional Comment** – there will be a detailed additional comment on specific next steps your child should take to improve their knowledge or exam technique in each subject area. We hope this provides support for families when helping your child with work at home.

This tracking will be used by Subject Leaders and the School Leadership Team to review the progress of each pupil in Year 7 and to help plan for success as we move forwards.

You will notice for PE and Personal Development lessons there is no assessment percentage mark. This is replaced by a rating of either 'At Expected', 'Above Expected' or 'Below Expected'. As these subjects are non-examined we feel this provides the necessary information on your child's learning in these areas and is supported by comment and other judgements.

I hope you find this useful in supporting your child's progress. You will have the opportunity to discuss the report with your child's teacher during parents' evening.
