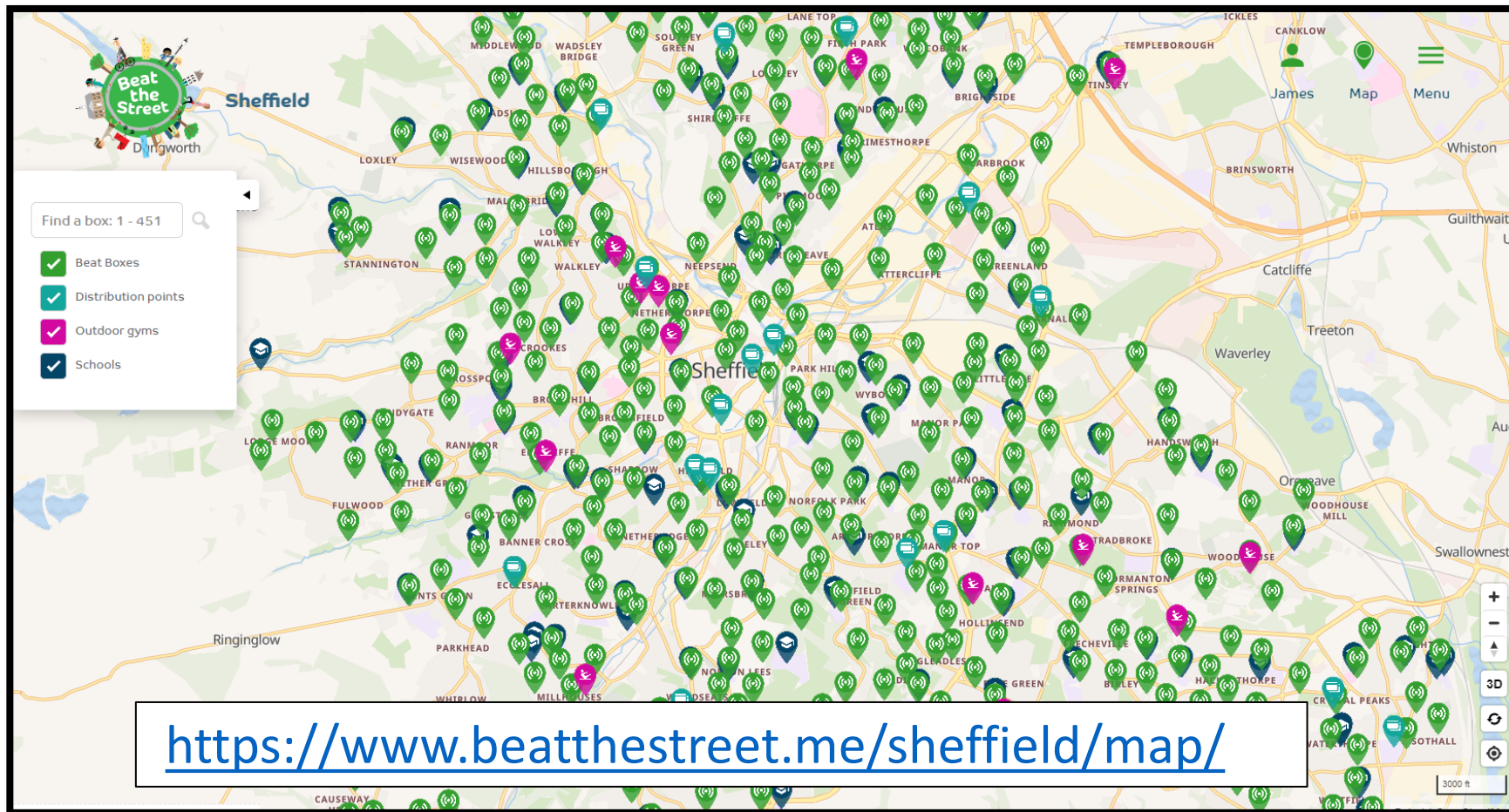


What is Beat the Street?

- Beat the Street turns the whole city into a giant game. There will be 450 'Beat Boxes' spread across every area of Sheffield. Players earn points by walking, cycling or running to a Beat Box. After finding their first Beat Box, players then earn 10 points for every Box they can find.



What is Beat the Street?



- Your points are recorded on the Beat the Street Sheffield website. When you play again, you keep automatically adding to your team's score.
- The Game meets COVID requirements – players only need to hover their card over the Beat Box to win points.
- Beat the Street is all about encouraging everyone to enjoy the **physical, mental and social health benefits of being active** whilst exploring their city. Sheffield has so many fantastic green spaces and cultural attractions to explore!
- Beat the Street is free for everyone to play! Play with your friends or with your family.
- **For your own safety make sure your parents know where you are when you are playing.**



How can I play?



1. Collect a card from the PE block
2. Register your card online at <https://www.beatthestreet.me/sheffield/>
3. Join your team on the registration page – the PE department has set up the following teams:

- Forge Valley Y7s
- Forge Valley Y8s
- Forge Valley Y9s
- Forge Valley Y10s
- Forge Valley Staff

The Forge Valley Teams will be on the website by the end of the week but you can start playing immediately and link your account to your team at a later date.

4. The Game begins on **Wednesday 16th June** and will run for 6 weeks until **Wednesday 28th July** (you can join at any stage)
